Although shingle roofs aren't typical TMR fare, if you throw in some complications, we can be there to help you out. The main complication on this project was the existing tile roof system was asbestos. Fortunately, we keep a fully trained and certified abatement team in house for just such a situation. In addition there was a large amount of difficult soffit and fascia work around the entire perimeter that could only be reached with some specialized equipment that we were able to mobilize for the effort. All in all the University got an excellent new roof system in time for fall classes with no unnecessary exposure to health issues as a result of the asbestos abatement
