DESCRIPTION This project consisted of several different roof areas on separate planes in various sections of the hospital. Safety and logistics were the two critical concerns on this project.

Rubber roofs were removed along with all on the existing insulation. This revealed metal decks, concrete decks, gypsum decks in other locations. The insulation requirements varied between sections. Some areas received higher "R" values according to the owner's specific requirements. While others used less to minimize cost.

In order to limit the amount of fumes in the hospital; some sections were installed in Garland's Weatherking Adhesive. This roofing adhesive greatly reduces the amount of annoying fumes entering these critical areas. Other sections utilized a two ply modified asphalt roof system by Garland.

Tuscano-Maher Roofing Inc. shop-fabricated a tern coated stainless steel edge system to match the existing hospital.
