DESCRIPTION With the presence of asbestos containing materials in the flashing on Providence hall Tuscano-Maher Roofing Inc. had to take special precautions in removing the existing roof. We teamed up with ATS a reputable abatement contractor to remove the regulated substance. Our second partnership was with the Garland Company. Greg Kashur designed a bombproof specification to meet all of the colleges many requirements. Tapered isocyanurate insulation was installed in places that need some additional slope before 2 plies of Type IV fiberglass were installed in hot asphalt. Garlands super durable Stressply E cap membrane was then installed before the roof was flood coated and slagged. In an effort to save the college some money the existing extruded aluminum edge system was removed and then replaced.
